

INVESTITURE of the IMPERIAL SERVICE ORDER at BUCKINGHAM PALACE

on Saturday, 18th July, 1903.

The gentleman to be invested will attend in Uniform, Levée Dress, or Evening Clothes, reaching the Palace by the Grand Entrance at 10.15 a.m.

On being admitted into the Royal Presence he will advance opposite to The King and make the usual reverence by bowing and will then kneel on the right knee.

His Majesty will then invest him with the Insignia by affixing it to his left breast.

The recipient will then raise his right arm horizontally and the King will then place his hand on the wrist of the recipient who will raise it to his lips.

He will then rise and retire from the Royal Presence with the like reverence.
