MR. ABIJAH MURRAY.

A telegram from Edinburgh announces the death in that city yesterday morning of Mr. Abijah Murray, I.S.O., Secretary to the Scottish Local Government Board. Mr. Murray, who was born in 1852, joined the Board of Supervision, which afterwards became the Local Government Board, in 1873. He rose to the position of Chief Clerk, and, on the retirement of Mr. Falconer Stewart in 1909, was appointed Secretary to the Board. In early life he was an enthusiastic volunteer, a member of the Queen's Edinburgh Rifles, and a well-known shot. He was joint author of MacDugald and Murray's "Handbook of Public Health" and editor of "Green's Councillor's Manual."
