The death has occurred of Mr A. Murray, I.S.O., Secretary to the Local Government Board for Scotland. Mr Murray had been ailing for some time past, though always able to be at business. The deceased gentleman, who was about fifty-nine years of age, entered the office of the Board of Supervision in 1875. When that body was superseded by the Local Government Board he was appointed Staff Clerk, then Chief Clerk, and subsequently Secretary, the duties of which post he discharged with ability. Mr Murray was joint-editor with Mr Patten MacDougall of "Skelton's Handbook of Public Health," and he was also editor of the "Councillor's Manual." He is survived by a widow, two sons, and a daughter.
