MURDOCH, Pte. James Bissett, S/8527. 7th Bn. Seaforth Highlanders. Died of wounds 2nd Jan., 1916. Age 20. Son of Jane Bissett Kirkwood (formerly Murdoch) and the late James Murdoch, of Glasgow. VIII. C. 75.

MURDOCK (served as MURRAY), Lce. Cpl. A., 9578. 2nd Bn. Argyll and Sutherland Highlanders. 20th Oct., 1915. Age 28. Husband of Mrs. McIntyre (formerly Murdock), of 99, Norman St., Bridgeton, Glasgow. VIII. C. 50.

MURISON, Pte. Dudley Bartens, 1939. 1st Bn. London Scottish. 3rd Nov., 1914. Age 23. Son of John and Maria Murison, of 15, Church Crescent, Muswell Hill, London. III. B. 23.

MURPHY, Pte. Daniel, 3/3110. 1st Bn. Leinster Regt. Died of wounds 2nd March, 1915. Age 26. Son of Timothy and Margaret Murphy, of Killeens, Cork. III. C. 74.

MURPHY, Pte. John, S/7492. 1st Bn. Seaforth Highlanders. Died of wounds 13th Oct., 1915. Age 32. Son of Thomas and Margaret Murphy, of 80, Cuthbert St., Tannochside, Uddingston, Lanarkshire. VIII. C. 48.

MURPHY, Whlr. John, M/38485. Royal Army Service Corps attd. 25th Bde. Ammunition Col. Royal Garrison Artillery. 18th Nov., 1915. VIII. C. 57.

MURPHY, Cpl. Joseph, B/3008. 7th Bn. The Rifle Brigade. Died of wounds 5th Jan., 1916. Age 38. Ward of E. Brown, of 126, Edward St., New Cross, London. Served in the Soudan Campaign, Nile Expedition of 1898, and in the South African Campaign. VIII. C. 77.

MURRAY, Pte. Albert Edward, 10833. 12th/13th Bn. Northumberland Fusiliers. Died of wounds 16th Oct., 1917. Age 22. Son of James Murray (Army Vet. Corps) and Harriet Murray, of Hawthorn Cottage, Stakeford Lane, Choppington, Northumberland. VIII. I. 63.

MURRAY, Pte. Angus, 3/7282. 2nd Bn. Seaforth Highlanders. Died of wounds 24th May, 1915. Age 17. Son of Donald and Catherine McIver Murray, of 8, Swainbost, Ness, Stornoway. VIII. D. 40.
