 of our special Knowledge, full Power, sole Privilege, and Authority, in
 full Confidence in your Loyalty, Courage and good Conduct do by these
 Letters we do hereby Command you to be an Officer in Our Volunteer Forces from
 the 1st of July 1888. You are therefore carefully and diligently to
 be promoted to the Rank of 2nd Lieutenant or in such higher Rank as
 may be thought fit, and you are at all times to exercise and well discipline in
 the said Forces, and you are to use your best endeavours to
 cause the said Men serving under you and use your best endeavours
 to cause them to Obey you and to Obey your Orders and Directions as from time
 to time you may receive and follow such Orders and Directions as from time
 to time you may receive from your superior Officer according to the Rules and
 Regulations of the said Forces, and to be true and faithful to the
 said Trust hereby reposed in you.
